WOMEN

- ✓ Golf dresses, shirts or sleeveless shirts must have a collar, or be a recognisable golf design
- ✓ Women are permitted to wear their shirts untucked if the shirt is designed/shaped to be worn outside
- ✓ Golf or tailored trousers, shorts or skirts to be worn
- ✓ Golf shoes must be worn

MEN



MEN

- ✓ Shirts must have a collar and sleeves, or be of recognisable golf design, and tucked in at the waist
- ✓ Golf or tailored trousers, shorts to be worn
- ✓ Golf shoes must be worn

Turtle-necks or modern trends for tapered, zip collars and hoodies are permitted providing they are a recognisable golf design.

Headgear to be worn correctly i.e peaks facing forward.

Denim Jeans are permitted in the clubhouse provided they are smart, clean and not ripped.

✗ UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING ON THE MARTELLO COURSE

Trainers, denims, track suits, vests, football kit (or other sports) kits, cargo shorts, beachwear, non-golf attire tee shirts.

✗ UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Ripped or faded jeans, track suits, vests, football kit (or other sports) kits, beach wear, non-formal headgear, wet or dirty clothing.
